

NOTICE OF RACE

2014 Park City Sailing Fall Regatta

Jordanelle Reservoir, Park City, Utah

1. Rules.

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The organizing authority is the Park City Sailing Association.

1.3 The regatta is designated Category C in accordance with RRS Appendix 1, ISAF Regulation 20.

2. Eligible Classes

2.1 Ultimate 20s

2.2 Lasers/Laser Radial

2.3 420s

2.4 Optimist

2.5 Elliott 6meter

3. Inspection and Measurement. Class rules shall apply for each division unless changed by this NOR or amended in the SI. Sails and equipment may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta.

4. Eligibility and Entry.

4.1 A minimum of four entries are required to constitute a class.

5. Risk. It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

6.2 No warning signal will be made after 3:00 p.m. on the final day of the regatta.

6.3 The Race Committee may adjust the number of races each day to accommodate weather conditions.

8. Fees.

8.1 Required Fees (checks should be made payable to: Park City Sailing Association)
The entry fee is \$65.00 USD for a single handed boat. Entry fee for Ulimate 20's and Elliots will be \$195. Optimist will be \$40 per boat. Entry fee for 420's will be \$60 per boat. A \$10 late fee charge will be made for registration after September 30th

8.2 The entry fee includes dinner and dancing on Saturday night and fresh water for the competitors on the lake during each race day and a regatta T-Shirt (please designate t-shirt size on registration).

8.3 Additional tickets for Saturday's dinner can be purchased online or at the registration/check in desk the morning of September 22nd. \$35 per head

9. Sailing Instructions. Preliminary sailing instructions will be available on the Park City Sailing Association web site on or about September 1, 2014. A final version will be available at on-site registration.

10. Courses & Racing Area.

10.1 Courses will be Windward - Leeward of an appropriate length

10.2 The racing area will be on the Jordanelle Reservoir approx. one quarter mile South of the Personal Watercraft Ramp.

11. Scoring.

11.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used.

11.2 Seven races are scheduled, and a minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

11.3 All divisions will be scored as one-design.

12.2 Charters. Charters will be available on a limited basis through members of the fleet not participating in the racing and/or PCSA owned Optis, 420 and Elliot 6 Meters. Please contact Geoff at geoff.hurwitch@parkcitysailing.org to inquire about available boats.

12.3 Park Access: Access to the Jordanelle State Park has been pre-arranged and is paid for by your entry fee. Please inform the attendant at the booth that you are attending the the Park City Sailing Fall Regatta

12.4 Tows: Courtesy tows to the racing area may be available in the vicinity of the launch area; however, it is the responsibility of each competitor to be at the start on time.

12.5 Hospitality. Competitors and their guests are invited to use park facilities on race days. Refreshments will be available following racing on Saturday and Sunday. There will be a dinner on Saturday night. Guests of competitors may purchase additional dinner tickets.

12.6 Pets. The Jordanelle does welcome pets but they must be on leashes at all times.
