



ACCOMMODATIONS FOR ULTIMATE 20 NORTH AMERICANS

POINT RICHMOND, CA

The local area around the Point Richmond Yacht Club has limited accommodations and at present, the following recommendations can be made:

HOTEL MAC: Historic hotel building in downtown Point Richmond, CA. The Hotel Mac offers deluxe suites and exquisite rooms providing extraordinary comfort, elegance and warmth for Point Richmond visitors and business people. Our amenities include luxurious robes, queen size beds, refrigerator, cable TV and a safe for your valuables. Great food and bar downstairs. Call for availability and rates.

MARINA BAY SUITES AND INNS: Casual destination featuring modestly appointed rooms, an outdoor pool & a restaurant. This is close by the Club, but is frequently used by local contractors and is only ranked a 2 star hotel. Will be cheap but don't expect much else. Rates around \$90/night.

DOUBLETREE INN AT BERKELEY MARINA: This is a great location on the water and adjacent to the race area. It is a 4 star hotel and has great food and access to the club which is about 15 minutes away. Will also have great food in the hotel. Rates around \$230/night. There are many other hotels in the Berkeley area that may be cheaper, so check them out as they are convenient to the venue.

EXTENDED STAY SAN RAFAEL: This is across the Richmond Bridge (\$5 toll) from Club and has kitchens in the rooms and a pool. Also a favorite of contractors, but is near San Rafael where there is a large number of good restaurants. Rates around \$150/night. Only about 10 minutes from the Club.

MARIN SUITES CORTE MADERA: This is another suites hotel, some with kitchens. Also across the Richmond Bridge, but only 15 minutes from the club. Near nice shopping centers and grocery stores for food and supplies. Rates around \$150/night.

For those with RV's or campers, you can set up (no utilities or hook ups) in the adjoining lot to the Club and sleep overnight and use the facilities at the Club.

Airbnb and VRBO also have a number of listings for houses in the Point Richmond area and in San Rafael. Check those out for larger groups or families.

Finally, if you are really stuck, contact the local chair, Mike Josselyn, who will work hard to find something that will fit your budget and group.
